Rick Light developed a step-by-step *taharah* training PowerPoint presentation for the June 2006 *Chevrah Kadisha* and Jewish Cemetery Conference. This PowerPoint has been used again in many conferences since then.

At the 2010 Conference, the *taharah* demo was filmed. During the demo, Rick refers to a PowerPoint slide show.
